Martha Bean, our District NMI President led us in prayer for the 6 World Regions and the 163 countries we have missionaries in. We were then led in worship by Lara Hoaglan, Preston Broce, and Saralynn Vawter, with songs that helped us focus on the Lord and His plan to use our lives for His kingdom work. We then heard the testimonies of two men who have literally followed Jesus around the world: Dan Duke, Wycliffe Translator to Cameroon, Africa, and Acrame Alaki Charles, from Democratic Republic of the Congo. He and his family are now refugees in America. Each shared powerful stories of how God has led them through the years of their lives doing kingdom work. Acrame is a member in the Church of the Nazarene and has held a local minister's license. He feels led to unite with Southwest Church to have a ministry focusing on the Swahili speaking refugees in our area. We are very excited to see how God will work in this!

To cap off our missions service, we were taken to China while we listened to our guest missionary's journey in an anti-Christian, communist society. Challenging and inspiring! God truly has a plan to win this whole world!

So, as you can see, we experienced a small picture of the work of God around our world. What will it be like one day, when all tribes, tongues, and nations of believers, will assemble around the throne of our Lord in Heaven... forever worshipping our King? PERFECT HARMONY.
