REVIVED

Recently we have talked about getting an AED for the church. This is an automated external defibrillator. To put it simply, it's a heart shocker. It can analyze the rhythm of someone's heart and shock it back into rhythm as necessary. It is truly a life-saving device!

Somedays, I think I need a good shock to get my heart going for the day! Physically, and spiritually.

I believe more than ever Christianity, and the Church/Body of Christ, needs a jolt of power to surge through it...to awaken it and get it back on rhythm with the Lord! I believe this can happen, mainly because the Lord desires this to happen. When Jesus told his disciples that he would be leaving, he said "wait in Jerusalem until you have received the promise of the Father" which was the gift of the Holy Spirit. In the Last Days Magazine years ago, they wrote a piece on the late Keith Green and his life.

"When musician Keith Green died in a plane crash on July 28, 1982, the world lost a special man whose heart was aflame with the gospel message. Before his untimely end, Green took the world on his seven-year spiritual journey. He held back nothing and was consumed with loving Christ and the church." (CBN, courtesy of Last Day Ministries).

The power of the Cross and the work of the Holy Spirit change us, and then we change the world around us. This is why times of refreshing and renewal are important for the church. We need to capture the awfulness of sin again, as well as the glory and majesty of our God and King.

Blackaby says it this way,

"When Holy God draws near in true revival, people come under terrible conviction of sin. The outstanding feature of spiritual awakening has been the profound consciousness of the Presence and holiness of God." (Henry Blackaby)

But how does this happen? It's actually fairly simple, as Anne Graham Lotz declares.

"Revival begins when you draw a circle around yourself and make sure everything in that circle is right with God" (Anne Graham Lotz).

As I mentioned in the message Sunday, Jesus is saying to believers, there is so much more for those who will "hunger and thirst after righteousness...they shall be filled" (Matthew 5:3).
