

### FOUNDATION ISSUES

Basements: Some love them, others despise them. They can be finished and beautiful or have leaks and become an expensive hazard. We know by experience.

We found out through professionals that our basement wall leaks around the foundation. This is a problem, but it is not the only problem. We also found out that our block wall is deflecting, pushing inward toward the room — so much so that we can see a separation in the mortar joints of the blocks. Bummer! The Pros told us this will never get better on its own, only worse. Eventually the wall will fall in... Yikes! Thankfully, the Pros are handling our problem and soon all will be repaired... for a cost, of course.

Sin, like water, can cause immense damage if not dealt with. It too, will never get better on its own, and sometimes the damage can be lifelong. But instead of dealing with the foundational issue, humanity tries to mask it. We figure if the outside is pretty, then that is enough. Yet, we know the inside needs desperate repairs.

To deal with our foundational problem of sin, there are eight steps we can take:

#### First step: Acknowledge the problem.

1 John 1:8

If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.  $_{\mbox{\scriptsize NKIV}}$ 

The second step: Confession.

1 John 1:9

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive

us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. NKJV

#### The third step: Repentance. (Turn away)

Acts 3:19

Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out... NKJV

#### The fourth step: Receive.

Rom 10:9-11

...confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. NKJV

#### Step five: Walk with the Lord.

1 John 1:7

But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin. NKIV

#### Step six: What if we fail?

1 John 2:1

My dear children, I am writing this to you so that you will not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate who pleads our case before the Father. He is Jesus Christ, the one who is truly righteous.  $_{\rm NLT}$ 

#### Step seven: Yield to the Spirit

Acts 15:8-9

So God, who knows the heart, acknowledged them by giving them the Holy Spirit, just as He did to us, and made no distinction between us and them, purifying their hearts by faith. NKJV.

#### Step eight: Produce Good Fruit

Galatians 5:22-23

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law. And those who are Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. NKJV

Compare this with the life without God.

#### Galatians 5:19-21

Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told you in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

My recommendation: get the foundation fixed first, and then the rest will take care of itself.
