

WORK OUT YOUR SALVATION

Got a daunting task? Start small.

Whether you are wanting to declutter your home, change your eating habits, or becoming a stronger Christian (at home and in the world), baby steps are best at first. The old saying goes, "Rome wasn't built in a day." Great things happen generally over great time and great dedication.

One day there was a group of tourists in a quaint village, and they asked one of the natives sitting on a bench, "Were there any great leaders born here?" The man replied, "No, only babies."

The esteemed Apostle Paul was once himself a baby named Saul. His father was of the strictest sect of the Jews, a Pharisee, of the tribe of Benjamin, of pure and unmixed Jewish blood (Acts 23:6; Phil 3:5). Saul grew up a citizen of Rome and was educated at the Jewish school of sacred learning in Jerusalem as a student of the law. Who was his teacher? It was none other than the famed rabbi Gamaliel. Saul was an avid pursuer of what was right according to the law – so much to the point that he persecuted those who didn't follow it – as he was part of the Sanhedrin, the supreme Jewish Court of Justice in Jerusalem. However, on his way on the road to Damascus to persecute Christians, he was miraculously converted, and the Savior changed his direction and his name. He was now Paul, but he had a lot of growing to do.

One day, this well-educated and disciplined scholar with a dark past wrote to a church in Philippi while he was in chains for preaching the Gospel. He said, "Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my

presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling; for it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure" (Phil 2:12-13, NKJV). This seasoned leader now spoke like a young schoolboy learning his ABC's again. He didn't have life or his faith all figured out. In fact, on another occasion he transparently shared with them, "Not that I have already attained, or am already perfected; but I press on, that I may lay hold of that for which Christ Jesus has also laid hold of me. Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead, I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus" (Phil 3:12-14 NKJV). Paul was human and recognized he (and all of us) have room to grow... if we want to.

His encouragement concludes, "being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ" (Phil 1:6-7 NKJV). His point, work with the Lord on your faith, your praying, your attitude, your witness, for "if the Lord can work in and through me, He can certainly work in your life as well!"

Saul of Tarsus was a powerful lawyer in Rome's eyes, but even better, Paul the Apostle grew to become the greatest leader and apologist for the Kingdom of Christ. How? He and the Lord "worked" at it. Let's also "work" at it.
