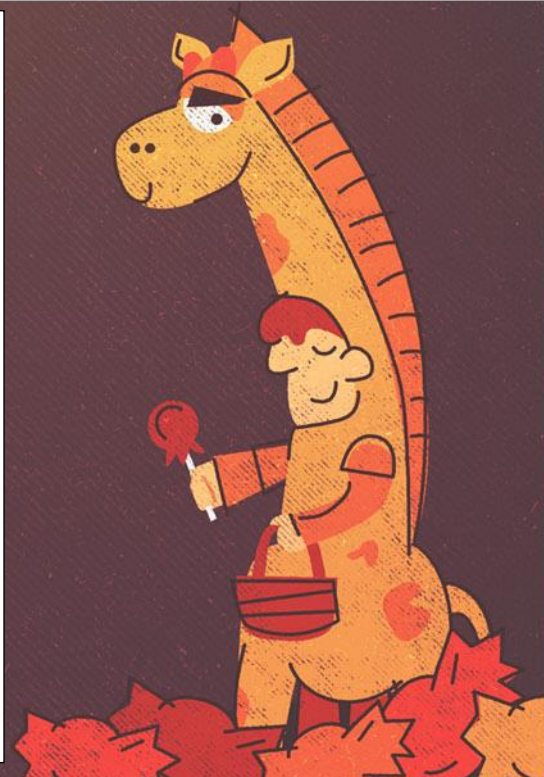

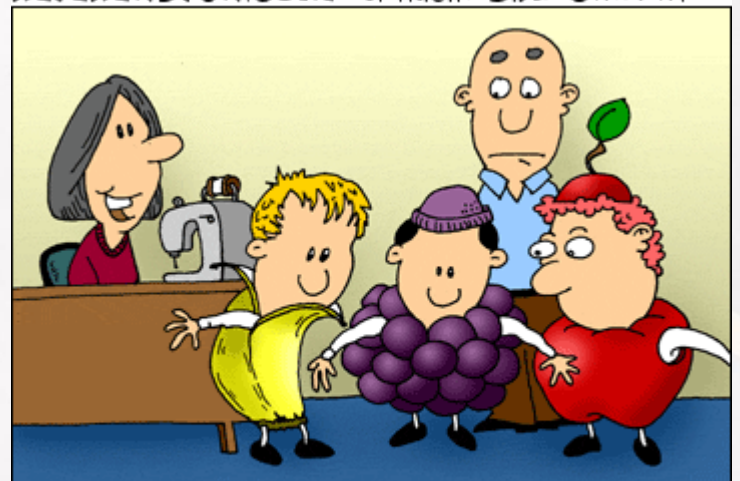


How can you help? Needed for Trunk or Treat:
