Coming this spring...

Maintenance on our 25,000 sq. ft. building is continual and costly. Through your faithful giving we can update our facility's needs in a timely manner. Our current projects are:

- 1.) Replacing Carpet in the board room and offices. After our sanctuary remodel, we had several boxes of carpet tiles left over. We plan on using these for the three office areas and believe we will still have enough spare tiles for any sanctuary repairs. No costs involved, praise the Lord!
- 2.) Replacing our Flat Roof. As most of you know, we have several leaks in our ceiling. This is due to our flat roof failing and needing replaced. The replacement cost for this will be around \$50,000. This will provide for a 20 year warranty with the manufacturer of the roof, We give God praise as we can pay for this in cash!
- 3.) Updating Old Sound Equipment. We have 25+year old sound equipment that needs replaced soon (amps and speakers). We will need to set aside funds for this or raise the funds, after we receive an acceptable quote. These items are generally expensive, fortunately, we will not need to replace them for a long time...hopefully another 25 years!

Again, thank you for you faithful giving to the Lord and His Church! We, as your church leadership, seek to always be good stewards of the funds we are entrusted with. To God be the glory, great things He hath done!
