#### Policy for Borrowing Tables & Chairs (Adapted Sept. of 2022):

- Church Participants can borrow folding tables or folding chairs with a one-month advance notice via a completed and approved "Request to Borrow" form.
- An individual may borrow chairs/tables up to two times per church year.
- The plastic folding tables and chairs located in the storage area off the Fellowship Hall are the only ones that may be borrowed.
- Borrowing folding tables or chairs is on a "first come" scheduling basis –managed by the church office manager.
- Tables or chairs will not be loaned out in the event of a scheduling conflict with a church sponsored activity or event.oTables and chairs must be returned in the original condition from when loaned out and to the original location within the church.
- Tables and chairs must be returned on the date agreed upon per the request form.oAny damage to the tables or chairs will be the responsibility of the individual borrowing the table(s) or chair(s).
- A \$50.00 deposit for borrowing tables and chairs is required at time of pick up and will be refunded if items returned in same condition as when borrowed.
